ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- (1) Applicants must in the first instance, meet the relevant O'Level requirement(s) for an award of a First Degree of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University:
 - (a) A Credit in English and Mathematics is required for all courses;
 - (b) Psychology requires at least a Pass in Biology or Health Sciences;
 - (c) A Credit pass in O'level Literature is required for programmes in the Department of English, Languages & Linguistics, Theatre Arts and Law, while a Pass in Literature is required for Language Education programme;
 - (d) 'O' Level Credit pass in Economics is required for all Management Science courses and Economics;

- (e) IJMB 'O; Level Credit Pass in Mathematics and English is acceptable in lieu of Credit pass at SSC or GCE 'O' Level English;
- (f) NCE English major is acceptable in lieu of 'O' Level Literature;
- (g) NCE Use of English is acceptable in lieu of 'O' Level Credit pass in SSC or GCE 'O' Level English.
- (h) In all cases, 'A' Level Passes supersede 'O' Level Passes.

(2) Master's Degree Programmes (M.Sc., M.A. and M.Ed)

Candidates must possess in addition to (1) above, a first relevant degree with a minimum of Second-Class Lower Division (CGPA of 2.50) from Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or any University recognized by the Senate of Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University.

- i) For M.Sc Physiology and Anatomy, candidates must possess B.Sc. First Class or Second Class in Physiology of the University or from any other University recognized by the Senate of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or Medical graduates of this University or any other University recognized by the Senate of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University, who are fully registered with Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria as Doctors.
- ii) For M.Sc Mathematics and Computer Science, candidates must possess B.Sc. Mathematics or Computer Science respectively of the University or from any other University recognized by the Senate of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 Candidates with Bachelor's degree in related fields such as Mathematics Education, Statistics, Mathematics/Statistics, Statistics/Computer Science or PGD in Mathematics or related field at a minimum pass level of 2.50/5.00 may be considered for M.Sc Mathematics while candidates with Bachelor's degree in related fields like Mathematics, Physics, Electrical/Electronic Engineering, B.Sc. (Ed) Computer and Information Management or PGD in Computer Science with a minimum of CGPA of 2.50 may be considered for M. Sc Computer Science. Such candidates may be required to make up for any deficiencies by attending appropriate module(s) from the school's undergraduate programme.
- iii) For M. Sc. Geography, the undergraduate degree will be in Geography, but applications are welcomed from second class upper degree from relevant, related backgrounds like Zoology, Geology, Biology and Environmental Management. However, applicants must demonstrate that they have the necessary background to pursue Postgraduate work in their field of specialization.
- iv) For M. Sc. Physics, candidates must possess B.Sc. Degree with a minimum of 2.50 CGPA in Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics from Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University with adequate background in undergraduate Physics or any other University recognized by the Senate of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or its equivalent.

- v) M.Sc. In Humanitarian and Refugee Studies is open to graduates of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University and other approved universities and higher institutions recognized by the Senate of the University, with good honours degree in the Social Sciences, Public Health and related disciplines; Agriculture and Forestry, Veterinary Medicine, Environmental Science, Town Planning, Science and Engineering or equivalent professional qualifications such as HND with a minimum of Lower Credit; Work related experience, especially in humanitarian activities in government and the private sector will be an added advantage.
- vi) For M. A. in Religion and Peace Studies, admission is open to graduates of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University and other approved universities with 2nd class honours degree in the Social Sciences and related disciplines or equivalent professional qualifications such as HND with minimum of Lower Credit; Work experience especially in Religious and Peace activities will be an added advantage.
- vii) For M.A. English, Candidates must possess a good Bachelor's degree in English Language or English Literature, or B.A. Education/English or Linguistics not lower than a Second-Class Lower Division, with a CGPA of 2.50 and above from a recognized University.
- viii) For MLIS, candidates must possess Bachelor's degree in Library and Information Science of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or other recognized Universities with a minimum of 2.50 CGPA or a Postgraduate Diploma in Library and Information Science at Credit Level.
- ix) For M. Sc. In Social Work, candidate must possess a good Bachelor's degree in Social Work or its equivalent with not less than Second-Class Lower Division having obtained a minimum of 2.50 on a 5-point scale, or a Bachelor's degree in any field plus a Postgraduate Diploma in Social Work or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 on a 5-point scale.
- x) For LL.M, candidates must hold a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) degree with a Second-Class Lower Division and above of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or from any other University recognized by the Senate of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University. All candidates must possess basic entry qualifications into the undergraduate programme to study Law degree as approved by the Senate of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University, Makurdi.
- xi) Master of Science Degree (M.Sc) in Disaster and Risk Management is open to graduates of this Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University and other approved universities and higher institutions recognized by the senate of the University, with good Honours Degrees in the Social Sciences, Public Health and related disciplines. Agriculture and Forestry, Veterinary Medicine, Environmental Science, Town Planning, Science and Engineering. Work experience, especially in disaster and risk management activities, in government and the private sector will be an added advantage. In addition, all candidates must satisfy Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu

- University basic requirements for matriculation and admission requirements of the School of Postgraduate Studies.
- xii) Master of Science Degree (M.Sc) in Medical Microbiology is open to graduates of this Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University and other approved universities and higher institutions recognized by the senate of the University, with good Honours Degrees in Microbiology and other related disciplines; With a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) degree or Possess at least a third-class degree or HND in Microbiology related disciplines with a postgraduate diploma. In addition, all candidates MUST have five credit passes in English, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
- xiii) For all M.Sc. Chemistry programmes, candidates MUST have five O'level credit passes including English, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology and Physics, in not more than two sittings. Agricultural Science is accepted in lieu of Biology, in addition to a pass in Physics for Environmental Management and Toxicology programmes. Also, Candidates can only be admitted into master degree, if their *transcripts* for certificates tendered are received at Postgraduate School at the time of consideration of application for admission.

xiv) M.Sc. Applied Conservation Programme;

- a) candidates must have five credit passes including English, Mathematics and three other relevant subjects including Biology and any other two subjects from Chemistry, Physics, Agricultural Sciences, Geography, Animal husbandry and Commerce or Economics at 'O' Level.
- b) Candidates with Bachelor's degree from an approved university must obtain a minimum of Second-Class Lower division degree with CGPA of 2.50
- c) Candidates with Bachelor's degree from an approved university who obtained a Third-Class degree in the relevant Biological Sciences discipline and has a Postgraduate Diploma in any Biological Sciences discipline May be considered for admission.
- d) Candidates with Bachelor's degree in Biology Education from an approved university with a minimum of Second lass Lower division degree as stated in **(b)** above may also be considered for admission.
- e) Holders of HND in relevant Biological Sciences programmes from approved institutions with a minimum of Upper Credit and a Postgraduate Diploma in any Biological Sciences discipline May also be considered for admission.

(3). Professional Master

(a) M. Sc. Management and Master in Public Sector Accounting

- i) Minimum of Second-Class Lower Division (CGPA of 2.50) with Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration/Management, Accounting, Banking & Finance, Marketing, Management, Economics from recognized universities.
- ii) Candidates must have attained a satisfactory level of performance in the University's Admission Test & Interview.
- iii) Candidates with PGDM from recognized universities and who have passed with a minimum of Upper Credit (CGPA of 3.50) may also be considered for admission provided the University's matriculation requirements are satisfied. In addition, candidates must possess as in (1) above.

(b) Master of Health Management (MHM)

- i) Any Degree in Medicine (MBBS and BDS). Degree in Pharmacy, and Honours Degree in Nursing and other medical professional degrees.
- ii) Advanced Diploma in Health Management of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University with a minimum of CREDIT pass average and any other relevant postgraduate diploma/qualifications.
- iii) In addition, candidates must possess as in (1) above.

(c) Master of Public Health (MPH)

- i) Medical degree (MBBS or BDS) or equivalents from Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or other Universities approved by the Senate of the Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University with not less than 2.50 CGPA.
- ii) Graduates of Nursing, Pharmacy and other relevant health and biological sciences are eligible for admission.
- iii) Experience in Public Health practice at Federal, State or Local Government levels in Public or Private organizations will be an added advantage.
- iv) In addition, candidates must possess as in (1) above and be subjected to admission test for selection into the programme.

(d) Master of Reproductive Health (MRH)

- i) Graduates of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or other recognized University possessing degrees in Medicine (MBBS, BM, BCH, MD) who are fully registered with the Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria.
- ii) Graduates of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or any other University recognized by the Senate of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University holding

- a B.Sc (First Class or Second-Class honours degree) in Nursing, Physiology and Anatomy with not less than 2.50 CGPA on a 5.0-point scale or its equivalent.
- iii) In addition, candidates must possess as in (1) above be subjected to admission test for selection into the programme.

(e) Master of Business Administration (MBA)

- i) Minimum of Second-Class Lower Division with Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration/Management, Accounting, Banking & Finance, Marketing, Management, Economics from recognized universities.
- ii) Candidates must have attained a satisfactory level of performance in the University's Admission Test & Interview.
- iii) Candidates with PGDM from recognized universities and who have passed with a minimum of Upper Credit (GPA 3.50) may also be considered for admission provided the University's matriculation requirements are satisfied. In addition, candidates must possess as in (1) above.

(f) Master's in Gender Studies (MGS)

- i) Candidates who hold a degree in any field with a second-class honours division and above from any University recognized by the Senate of the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University with a CGPA of at least 2.50.
- ii) Candidates who hold qualification with relevant experience deemed to be equivalent to (a) above by the Senate of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University.
- iii) Also, candidates must process basic entry qualifications into the undergraduate programme as in (1) above with a CGPA of 2.50 and above.

(4). M.Sc./PhD (Management/Marketing)

i) Candidates who have a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 4:0 and above in the M.Sc. Management/Marketing programme of the University in their first year would be scaled up for the PhD programme in the respective area of specialization.

(5). Doctor of Philosophy Programmes (PhD)

Candidates in addition to (i & ii) above, must have a good Masters Degree with a CGPA of not less than 3.50 or 'B' grade from Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or any University recognized by the Senate of Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University

i) For PhD. History, candidates with Master of Philosophy degree may be admitted for the programme, or candidates who do not hold an M.A. in History will be required to take a number of 800 level courses for one academic session.

- ii) For PhD programmes in Faculty of Education and in the Department of Business Administration in the Faculty of Administration and Management Sciences, candidates shall also be required to take a written and oral examination.
- iii) Furthermore, Candidates for PhD programmes in the Department of Arts and Social Science Education and Department of Business Management are required to consult the Head of Department as to the availability of supervisors in the areas they wish to specialize before applying.
- iv) For PhD. Law, applications should be accompanied by a research proposal.
- v) For PhD. Physiology and Anatomy, candidates must be fully registered with Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria as Doctors.
- vi) For PhD Industrial Technology Education candidates must satisfy UME requirements of five O-level passes at Credit level which must include English, Mathematics and any three of Chemistry, Physics, Technical Drawing, Biology, Principles of Accounting, Economics, Agricultural Science or any other subject deemed relevant to the programme from any of the following examination bodies: FCTC, NABTEB, WAEC or NECO. In all cases candidates must be expected to undergo a screening process.
- vii) For PhD. Physics candidates must have a minimum of an M.Sc. Degree in Physics or its equivalent with a minimum of 3.50 grade point on a 5-point scale from Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or any other University recognized by the Senate of the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University.
- viii) For PhD. Geography candidates require an M.Sc/M.Phil degree in Geography or equivalent. The programme also allows exceptional students to be admitted directly from the Masters' program; they must have demonstrated a superior academic record (i.e. attained an A average in all their M.Sc course work) and have satisfied other conditions (details of which can be obtained from the Head of Department). Ph.D candidates will be admitted only to specializations where there are qualified resident supervisors.
 - ix) For PhD Development Studies candidates must attain a minimum of Master's degree in Development Studies or equivalent from Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or other recognized universities of equivalent status. Candidates who have attained a minimum of 3.50 CGPA in the M.Sc/M.Phil will be admitted. Exceptional students as detailed above will also be considered for admission.
 - x) For Ph.D Materials Science and Renewable Energy Physics, admission is open to candidates who have a minimum of M. Sc. Degree in the chosen area of specialization or its equivalent with a minimum of 3.50 on a 4-point scale from Benue State University or any other university recognized by the Senate of the Benue State University.

- xi) For PhD. English, candidates must possess a good Master's degree in English Language or Literary Studies from a recognized University, with a CGPA not below 3.50 on a five-point scale.
- xii)For PhD Public Administration candidates must have obtained a first degree in Public Administration or a related degree(s) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 on a 5-point scale; applicants must have a Master of Science (M. Sc) in Public Administration or related fields with a CGPA of 3.50 on a 5-point scale from the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or any other institution recognized by the Senate of the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University.
- xiii) For Ph.D Library and Information Science, candidates must possess a Master Degree in Library and Information Science of the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or other recognized Universities with a least a CGPA of 3.50
- xiv) For Ph.D Social Work, candidates must hold a certificate of qualification in Social Work, must possess a Master's degree in Social Work passed with a score of 60% (or a CGPA of 3.50) from any recognized institution approved by the Senate of the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University, or holder of PGD Social Work and any Master's degree in the Social Sciences with CGPA of 2.50 on a 5-point scale.
- xv) For Ph.D. Biology Education, Ph.D. Mathematics Education (Sc-Ed), Ph.D. Chemistry Education and Ph.D. Physics Education. All candidates must have at least five O'level credit passes which must include English language and Mathematics. All candidates must possess a Master Degree either M.Sc. (Ed) or M.Ed. (Science) in Biology Education, Mathematics Education, Chemistry Education and Physics Education of the Rev Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University or other recognized Universities with a least a CGPA of 3.00.

(6) Postgraduate Diploma

- **(a) Postgraduate Diploma in Planning Studies**, the Department provides a 12 months programme leading to the award of Postgraduate Diploma in Planning Studies. Intending applicants are expected to:
- i) Have the University Entry (WASC or NECO at not more than 2 sittings) requirement of at least 5 credits, which must include English and Mathematics and any three subjects from the following: Geography, Chemistry, Biology or Agricultural Science, Economics, Technical Drawing, OR
- ii) Have a General Certificate of Education (GCE O-Level) passes in 5 subjects at Credit level and at least a credit in Mathematics and any 2 subjects from the following: Geography, Chemistry, Biology or Agricultural Science, Economics, Technical Drawing, NABTED, AND
- iii) A Bachelor's Degree in any of Geography, Economics, Sociology, Psychology, Estate Management, Building, Architecture or Civil Engineering or Urban and Regional Planning with at least a 3rd Class honours or an HND in Urban and

Regional Planning, Architecture or Estate Management with at least Credit level pass.

(b) Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science

The Department provides that a candidate must pursue their studies for not less than 3 semesters and not more than 4 semesters from the date of registration.

- i) Candidates must possess basic entry qualification into the undergraduate programme (5 credits which must include English Language and Mathematics).
- ii) A minimum of 3rd Class Degree in Computer Science or CGPA 2.00 for Computer Science Graduates or Lower Credit for HND graduates.
- iii) Candidates who do not have Degrees or HND in Computer Science but who have minimum of 2nd Class Lower Degree in Engineering, Architecture, Mathematics, Statistics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics and Geography may be admitted into PGD in Computer Science or any other relevant discipline.

(c) Postgraduate Diploma in Gender Studies

The Center provides that the programme is open to holders of:

- i) A Bachelors' degree not below Third Class Honours or HND not below Lower Credit in any related discipline from a recognized university.
- ii) Any NUC approved equivalent to Professional qualifications recognized by the Senate of the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University.
- iii) A minimum of five (5) credit passes at GCE/SSC/NECO/NABTEB ordinary level (obtained at not more than two (2) sittings including English Language.

(d) Postgraduate Diploma in Mass Communication (PGDMC)

The programme takes three semesters: two intensive course work and one semester of original research project.

- i) Candidates must possess basic entry qualification into the undergraduate programme (5 credits which must include English Language and Mathematics).
- ii) A minimum of 3rd Class Degree in Mass Communication or CGPA of 2.00 for Mass Communication Graduates or Lower Credit for HND graduates.

(e) Postgraduate Diploma in Accounting (PGDA)

To qualify for admission into the PGDA, provided that the University's matriculation requirements are satisfied, a candidate must:

- i) Obtain a degree with a minimum of 2nd class lower division in non-accounting related fields from a recognized university.
- ii) Obtain a Pass Degree or 3rd Class in Accounting and other related fields in Accounting.

- iii) Obtain HND in Accounting (Upper Credit) obtained from a recognized University or Polytechnic.
- iv) Obtain HND (Lower Credit) in Accounting and other related disciplines from a recognized Polytechnic.
- v) Obtain at least a Masters Degree in a non-related discipline from a recognized University.
- vi) Obtain any other academic or professional qualification deemed appropriate.

(f) Postgraduate Diploma in Library and Information Science

The programme is designed to develop awareness and interest in Library and Information Science as a discipline and to remedy students' knowledge deficiencies in LIS. It is open to holders of:

- i) A Bachelors' degree not below Third Class Honours in Library and Information Science.
- ii) Candidates with first degrees in disciplines other than Library and Information Science.

(g) Postgraduate Diploma in Sociology

The programme is designed to equip the student with relevant skills in the areas of theory and empirical research and train them to be able to apply the fields off Sociology to effectively meet the challenges of a dynamic society. It is open to holders of:

- i) Candidates who hold Third Class (Hons) degree and above in Sociology or related disciplines awarded by an approved and recognized Universities.
- ii) Candidates who hold HND or Professional qualifications cognate to Sociology from a recognized institution with not less than Upper Credit.

(h) Postgraduate Diploma in Social Work

The objective of the diploma is to provide programme opportunity and training for graduates of other disciplines to convert to the profession of social work at the managerial level as well as to prepare students to pursue higher degrees in the discipline. It is open to holders of:

- i) Candidates who hold Third Class (Hons) degree and above in any related disciplines awarded by an approved and accredited University.
- ii) Candidates who hold HND or Professional qualifications cognate to Social Works from a recognized institution with not less than Upper Credit

(I) Postgraduate Diploma (PGDArb and PGDHLDM)

i) The objective of the diploma is to provide programme opportunity and training for graduates of other disciplines to convert to the profession of social work at the

- managerial level as well as to prepare students to pursue higher degrees in the discipline. It is open to holders of:
- ii) Candidates who hold a Bachelor's degree in Law or any relevant discipline as may be required from a Nigerian university or any other acceptable University with a minimum of Second-Class Honours (Lower Division) or its equivalent.
- iii) An applicant with a Third Class Honours or Pass degree with some post-graduation experience may be considered. A Nigerian citizen must show evidence of having participated in the National Youth Service Corps programme or got an exemption.
- iv) An applicant should provide a minimum of two positive references as to character and learning and at least one of the references must be obtained from the applicant's former Lecturers in the University s(he) attended.
- v) There may be a qualifying examination for applicants for the purpose of admission into the Faculty's Postgraduate Diploma programmes.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

All programmes begin with Course Work and end at Project for Postgraduate Diplomas or Dissertation and Thesis for Master's and PhD degrees respectively. The duration of Degree/Diploma programmes are as follows:

- (i) Postgraduate Diploma programmes shall be of one year minimum and two years maximum duration.
- (ii) Master's Degree programmes shall normally be of one academic year minimum duration for full-time and two years for part-time candidates. The duration shall not normally exceed two years for full-time and three years for part-time candidates.
- (iii) **Doctorate Degree** programmes shall normally be of three years minimum duration for full-time and five years for part-time candidates. The duration shall not exceed five years for full-time and seven years for part-time candidates.
- **NOTE:** Applicants must request their previous institutions to forward their Academic Transcripts to: The Secretary, Postgraduate School, Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University, Makurdi. (Transcripts to be accompanied with transcript request forms which should be printed on the portal).

Print a copy of the pre-registration form.

- ii) Applicants would then proceed to the designated Bank (Fidelity) with the printed copy of preregistration form and pay a non-refundable application fee of *\text{\text{\$\mu}20,000}\$ using the generated Application Number.
- iii) After payment, applicants would be expected to re-visit the Rev. Fr. Moses Orshio Adasu University Portal under *Application* and click on Postgraduate to complete the Application Form. Then upload academic credentials and other relevant documents and submit on-line. Please, print a hard copy of the completed form for reference purposes.
- iv) Applicants are to ensure that the on-line reference forms are completed by the three referees.
- Please note that applications without relevant documents uploaded will not be considered.
- vi) Late purchase which commences 30 days after the date of the advert shall attract an additional fee of five thousand (N5,000.00) naira.

Guidelines for filling application forms

Applicants should provide all information sought in the form. Applications with incomplete information shall be treated as void. Proposed course of study including area of specialization if any should be clearly stated. Applicants should ensure that their official transcripts of academic record are forwarded to the Postgraduate School by their former universities. Applications without official transcripts of academic record shall not be processed. A candidate can apply for admission to only one Degree/Diploma programme at any given time.

The application costs twenty thousand naira (\$20,000).
